



The Chilliwack School District is excited to open a Before and After School care program at Greendale Elementary Community School (pending licensing to open September 2024).

The Greendale Elementary program employs certified Education Assistants to provide before and after school care. This inclusive care program is designed to provide continuity of learning for students across the school day while creating licensed before and after school care (license pending approval).

The program represents a growing connection between the education and childcare sectors and is part of B.C. government's 10-year ChildCare BC plan to build an inclusive universal child care system that meets B.C. communities' growing child care needs.

Not only is it convenient for parents to have school and care in one location, Early Childhood Educators, Education Assistants and our Primary teachers have a shared philosophy of learning, using B.C.'s Early Learning Framework as their guide.

Hours of operation:

- Before school: 7:00am – 8:00am
- After school: 1:58pm - 5:30pm

Fees for Before & After School Care:

- Kindergarten: \$205 per Month
- Grades 1 to 5: \$410 per month
- The fees listed above reflect the savings provided through the Child Care Fee Reduction Initiative, without CCFRI, the full monthly fee would be \$525
- *Eligible families may apply for the **BC Affordable Child Care Benefit Subsidy** to assist with Child Care fees.*
